R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Applications 9281 and 9282 were filed by A. V. Heller on June 27, 1930 for permission to appropriate 0.5 c.f.s. of water from Juniper Spring and 0.5 c.f.s. of water from Rosebush Spring, respectively, for stock-watering purposes. The proposed point of diversion and place of use under Application 9281 is described as within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 33, T. 33 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed point of diversion and place of use under Application 9282 is described as within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 30, T. 33 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M.

Protests were filed against these applications by Gerlach Livestock Co. and Gerlach and Waltz on August 9, 1930 and by Clark's Valley Land and Sheep Co. on September 13, 1930. No further action on these applications has been taken since that time.

Information in these files indicate that Mr. John Espil is the present owner of these applications. A letter was sent to Mr. Espil by certified mail on April 8, 1970 inquiring if he was interested in pursuing these applications and also informed him that it was necessary to submit documents assigning these applications into his name. No reply was received to this letter. A letter was sent to the applicant by certified mail on May 8, 1970 requesting additional information necessary before permits could be issued under these applications. This letter was returned to this office by Mrs. A. V. Heller with the following information on said letter: "Refer these filings to Mr. John Espil."

Ruling

Applications 9281 and 9282 are herewith denied on the grounds that neither the applicant nor the presumed present owner submitted the required information necessary before permits could be issued under these applications.
