

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATION NO. 10723  
FILED BY ROBINSON NEEMAN FOR PERMISSION  
TO APPROPRIATE WATER FROM TAMARACK CREEK  
IN WASHOE COUNTY, NEVADA. }

R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application No. 10723 was filed by Robinson Neeman on September 5, 1941 for permission to appropriate 0.04 cfs of water from Tamarack Creek for domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion is described as within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 17, T. 17 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use is described as within the N $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , W $\frac{1}{2}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , and NE $\frac{1}{4}$  said Section 17.

The applicant proposed to use this for a resort and cabins within the proposed place of use.

A protest was filed under this application by Frank and Will Sauer on August 10, 1942. No further action has been taken since that time. A memorandum, dated August 2, 1948, states that the First National Bank Trust Department, Reno, Nevada, holds this property in trust and that any notices should be sent to them. A letter was sent to the applicant, by certified mail, on May 22, 1970, requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on this application. This letter was returned, stamped "unknown", by the Post Office Department.

A letter, dated May 22, 1970, was sent to the First National Bank in Reno. This letter was returned by the addressee with a note "Does not belong to FNB".

RULING

Application No. 10723 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to submit the required information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application.
