R U L I N G

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GENERAL:

Application 5822 was filed by Sylvain Siard on October 24, 1919, for permission to appropriate 1.5 c.f.s. of water from Coyote Springs for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 32, T.30N., R.39E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use is described as 150 acres within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 32. This application was protested by Cooper and Uniacke on December 23, 1919.

Application 6140 was filed by Sylvain Siard on May 28, 1920, for permission to appropriate 0.35 c.f.s. of water from Pole Creek for stock watering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 35, T.30N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M. This application proposed to water 6,000 sheep and 500 head of cattle within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36, T.30N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M. This application was protested by W. H. Cooper and Son on August 14, 1920.

Application 6159 was filed by Sylvain Siard on June 8, 1920, for permission to appropriate 0.25 c.f.s. of water from Siard Spring for stock watering and domestic purposes. The water was proposed to be diverted and used for watering 9,000 sheep, 500 head of cattle and 100 head of horses within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 13, T.30N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M. This application was protested by W. H. Cooper and Son on August 14, 1920.

Application 6160 was filed by Sylvain Siard on June 8, 1920, for permission to appropriate 0.5 c.f.s. of water from Siard Spring for irrigation and stock watering purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 16, T.30N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use is described as 40 acres within the W $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ said Section 16. This application was protested by W. H. Cooper and Son on August 14, 1920.

Application 6161 was filed by Sylvain Siard on June 8, 1920, for permission to appropriate 0.25 c.f.s. of water from Siard Spring for stock watering and domestic purposes. The applicant proposed to water 600 head of cattle and 75 head

of horses at the point of diversion located within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36, T.30N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M. This application was protested by W. H. Cooper and Son on August 14, 1920.

Application 6484 was filed by Sylvain Siard on June 9, 1921, for permission to appropriate 2.0 c.f.s. of water from Pleasant Valley Creek for power purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 26, T.28N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M. The place of use is described as within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 26, T.28N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M. The applicant proposed to develop 20 H.P.

A letter was forwarded to Mr. Cesar Siard, agent for the applicant, on March 24, 1970, by certified mail, requesting additional information necessary before these applications could be processed for a permit. No reply has been received to this letter.

RULING

Applications 5822, 6140, 6159, 6160, 6162, and 6484 are herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his agent failed to submit the requested information necessary before permits could be issued under these applications.
