R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 27374 was submitted on March 28, 1973 by H & C Investment Co., Inc. to change the point of diversion and place of use of 5.4 c.f.s. of water from an underground source heretofore appropriated under Permit 26142 for irrigation and domestic purposes. The existing point of diversion is within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 7, T.32N., R.38E., M.D.B.& M., and the proposed point of diversion is within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 7. The existing place of use is 320 acres within the W $\frac{1}{2}$, Section 7, T.32N., R.38E., M.D.B.& M., and the proposed place of use is 320 acres within the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Section 7.

Application 27375 was submitted on March 28, 1973 by H & C Investment Co., Inc. to change the point of diversion and place of use of 5.4 c.f.s. of water from an underground source heretofore appropriated under Permit 26143 for irrigation and domestic purposes. The existing point of diversion is within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 7, T.32N., R.38E., M.D.B.& M., and the proposed point of diversion is within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 7. The existing place of use is 320 acres within the E $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 7, T.32N., R.38E., M.D.B.& M., and the proposed place of use is 320 acres within the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Section 7.

Applications 27374 and 27375 were both accompanied by the statutory \$30.00 filing fee. However, neither application was properly endorsed, either by the applicant, H & C Investment Co., Inc. or by their agent, Mr. C. H. Ketcham.

RULING:

Applications 27374 and 27375, as submitted, do not bear an original signature, therefore, are declared void. The total filing fee in the amount of \$60.00 will be returned to the applicant in the form of an excess remittance.
