R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 27380 was filed on March 28, 1973 by Fred A. Thaheld to appropriate 4.0 c.f.s. of the waters of an underground source to be diverted within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 33, T.14N., R.20E., M.D.B. & M. and to be used for the irrigation of 160 acres within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 33, T.14N., R.20E., and for domestic purposes.

This application was protested on June 14, 1973 by Martin Johnson on the following grounds:

"The continued granting of permission for large and small underground wells should be stopped. The granting of this well will directly affect the output of my well as those of my neighbors."

"I believe the saturation point has come upon us and the so-called unexhaustible underground supply is no more."

No Field Investigation in the matter of this application was made.

OPINION:

It is our opinion that the granting of this application will not tend to impair the value of existing rights nor be otherwise detrimental to the public welfare.

RULING:

The protest to the granting of Application 27380 is hereby overruled and a permit will be granted upon submission of the statutory permit fees and subject to existing rights.
