R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 27465 was filed on May 9, 1973 by John Lavern Whipple for permission to appropriate 2.7 c.f.s. of water from an underground source located within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 21, T.12N., R.62E., M.D.B. & M. to be used for the irrigation of 140 acres and for domestic purposes.


A protest to the granting of Application 27465 was filed on June 7, 1973 by Ronald Ivins on the grounds that: " I have a well situated approximately 1/2 mile west and south of proposed application. This application could effect the output of water for my permit". The protestant prayed that the application be "issued subject to prior rights".

A field investigation in the matter of this application was conducted on August 7, 1973.

RULING:

The protest to the granting of Application 27465 is hereby sustained and a permit will be granted subject to existing rights upon receipt of the statutory permit fees.
