GENERAL:


Application 27702 was filed on August 20, 1973 by Charles F. Schuetz to appropriate 5.0 c.f.s. for the waters of an underground source to be diverted within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 26, T.17N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M. to be used for the irrigation of 200 acres of land within the E $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , N $\frac{1}{2}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  said Section 26 and domestic purposes.

This area was designated on January 22, 1973 by order of the State Engineer. Present information available indicates that the estimated perennial yield of the Dayton Valley ground water basin is 7900 acre feet. Existing water rights of record within the Dayton Valley underground basin exceeds the estimate of perennial yield.

RULING:

Application 27702 is hereby denied on the grounds that the granting of this application for additional withdrawal of water from this area of the Dayton Valley ground water basin would adversely affect and tend to impair the value of existing water rights.
