R U L I N G

Application 25864 was filed on November 12, 1970, by R. W. Webb to change the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 11961, Certificate 4555. Certificate 4555 was issued for 2.85 c.f.s. for the irrigation of 200 acres of land. Application 25864 was to change 2.65 c.f.s. and 186 acres of land.

Application 25887 was filed on December 10, 1970, by R. W. Webb to change the point of diversion of a portion of Permit 11961, Certificate 4555. The well drilled under Permit 11961 has collapsed and is no longer usable.

These applications were protested by the Muddy Valley Irrigation Company and they were the subject of a field investigation held on July 28, 1971, and numerous informal discussions with the applicant and the protestants since that time.

OPINION:

It is our opinion that the granting of Applications 25864 and 25887 will not tend to impair the value of existing rights or be otherwise detrimental to the public welfare. Ground water to be developed by this well will not affect surface waters. The granting of these permits does not allow additional water or expanded acreage.

RULING

The protests to the granting of Application 25864 and 25887 are herewith overruled on the grounds that their granting will not tend to impair the value of existing rights or be otherwise detrimental to the public welfare.
