R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 29213 was filed by Sierra Pacific Power Company on February 11, 1975, for permission to change the point of diversion, manner and place of use of 2.53 c.f.s. of water under Claim 639, Truckee River Decree. The water is to be used for industrial purposes. The proposed point of diversion is within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 33, T.20N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M. The point of diversion under Claim 639 is within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 9, T.20N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use under this application is portions of Sections 28, 32, and 33, T.20N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M. The existing place of use under Claim 639 is 66.7 acres within portions of Section 34, T.21N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M. This claim is of record in the name of M. P. Depaoli, W. J. and J. A. Ceresola and Estate of Louis M. Ceresola.

Application 29214 was filed by Sierra Pacific Power Company on February 11, 1975, for permission to change the point of diversion, manner and place of use of 1.55 c.f.s. of water under Claim 640, Truckee River Decree. The water is to be used for industrial purposes. The proposed point of diversion is within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 33, T.20N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M. The existing point of diversion under Claim 640 is within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 9, T.20N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use under this application is portions of Sections 32, 33 and 28, T.20N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M. The existing place of use is 41.2 acres within a portion of Section 33, T.21N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M. Claim 640 is of record in the name of M. P. Depaoli, W. J. and J. A. Ceresola and Estate of Louis M. Ceresola.

Application 29215 was filed by Sierra Pacific Power Company on February 11, 1975, for permission to change the point of diversion, manner and place of use of 5.39 c.f.s. of water under Claim 642, Truckee River Decree. The water is to be used for industrial purposes. The proposed point of diversion is within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 33, T.20N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M. The existing point of diversion is within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 33, T.21N., R.24E. The proposed place of use is portions of Sections 28, 32 and 33, T.20N., R.22E. The existing place of use is 144.2 acres within portions of Sections 22, 27, 28 and 33, T.21N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M. Claim 642 is of record in the name of D. Ceresola.


Application 29216 was filed by Sierra Pacific Power Company on February 11, 1975, for permission to change the point of diversion, manner and place of use of Claim 645, Truckee River Decree. The proposed use is for industrial purposes. The proposed point of diversion is within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 33, T.20N.,R.22E., M.D.B.&M. The existing point of diversion under Claim 645 is within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 15, T.21N.,R.24E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use is the same as described under Application 29213. The existing place of use is 80.3 acres within portions of Sections 8 and 9, T.21N.,R.24E., M.D.B.&M. Claim 645 is of record in the name of M. P. Depaoli, W. J. and J. A. Ceresola and Estate of Louis M. Ceresola.

Certified documents have been submitted completing the chain of title from the owner of record of these claims down to W. J. and J. A. Ceresola. An agreement has been submitted between W. B. Ceresola, administrator of the estate of W. J. Ceresola, and Ceresola Brothers, seller, and Sierra Pacific Power Company, buyer. The terms of this agreement state that the final transaction cannot be completed under this sale until Sierra Pacific Power Company receives permits under the applications to change. No deed will be issued to Sierra Pacific Power Company until such time as the purchase price has been paid.

RULING

The above-described agreement will be accepted and filed for the completion of the chain of title for Claims 639, 640, 642, 645, Truckee River Decree, to Sierra Pacific Power Company on the condition that within sixty (60) days following the issuance of permits, if in fact permits are issued, under Applications 29213, 29214, 29215, and 29216, to change, a certified copy of the deed between William B. Ceresola and Ceresola Brothers, sellers, and Sierra Pacific Power Company, buyer, must be submitted to this office. Failure to submit said document will result in the cancellation of any permits issued under applications to change, 29213, 29214, 29215 and 29216.
