} RULING

General:

Applications Nos. 15623, 15624 and 15625 were filed for ground water with the diversions to be in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 17, T. 38 N., R. 39 E.; SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 16, T. 38 N., R. 39 E. and in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 16, T. 38 N., R. 39 E., respectively.

The location of the points of diversion are between nine and ten miles downstream from the lowest irrigated lands of the Frank McCleary Cattle Company and it is the opinion of the State Engineer that the development of ground water at the proposed points of diversion could not affect the vested rights of the protestant.

RULING

The protest of the Frank McCleary Cattle Company is overruled and permits will be granted under Applications Nos. 15623, 15624 and 15625, subject to all prior rights on the source.
