Applications 29001 was filed December 6, 1974 by Orville F. Lynch to appropriate 0.75 c.f.s. of water of an underground source to be diverted within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 26, T.36N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M; to be used for the irrigation of 11.8 acres within the W $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 26 and domestic purposes.

Approved appropriations from the ground water from the Winnemucca Segment of the Humboldt River Valley exceed the perennial yield of the Winnemucca Segment.


OPINION:

It is our opinion that the granting of additional appropriations in an area where existing approved appropriations exceed the perennial yield of the area would tend to impair the value of existing rights and be otherwise detrimental to the public welfare.

RULING:

Application 29001 is hereby denied on the grounds that its granting would tend to impair the value of existing rights and be otherwise detrimental to the public welfare.
