GENERAL:

Application 28999 was filed on December 5, 1974, by William Joseph Richter to appropriate 6.0 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for the irrigation of 110 acres, Douglas County, Nevada.

The proposed point of diversion is within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 19, T.14N., R.20E., M.D.B. & M. The place of use is within the E $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 19, T.14N., R.20E., M.D.B. & M.

OPINION:

It is our opinion that the granting of additional appropriations in the amount applied for under Application 28999 and other applications in the same concentrated area would tend to impair the value of existing rights and be otherwise detrimental to the public welfare.

RULING:

Application 28999 is hereby denied on the grounds that the granting of this application would tend to impair the value of existing rights and be otherwise detrimental to the public welfare.
