GENERAL:

On October 3, 1974, Michael T. and Nancy C. Miluck filed Application 28770 to appropriate 0.5 c.f.s. of underground water for Quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion is within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 9, T.13N., R.19E., M.D.M. and the place of use is five acres within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 9. Five residences are to be served at the place of use.

On January 10, 1975, Carl J. and Hope Falcke filed a protest to Application 28770 asking that it be denied.

The proposed development has been approved by the Douglas County Commissioners.

There are three water rights within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 9 to divert a total of 0.56 c.f.s. or 92 acre-feet per year of ground water.

RULING:

The protest to Application 28770 is hereby overruled and a permit will be granted upon receipt of statutory fees.
