R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 27856 was filed October 23, 1973 by William Henry Scott to appropriate 0.2 c.f.s. from Dog Spring located within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 21, T.37N., R.41E. The water is to be used for quasi-municipal purposes in fourteen single family dwellings to be located within Section 21 and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27, T.37N., R.41E., M.D.B.& M.

A protest to the granting of Application 27856 was filed on March 7, 1974 by Jo Hibbs Christison on the grounds that the application would interfere with existing stockwatering rights on Dog Spring.

A Field Investigation into the matter of protested Application 27856 was conducted on August 20, 1974. The flow from Dog Spring was measured to be 1.0 gallon per minute at the time of the investigation and this flow is believed to be constant regardless of the season. Such a flow would be adequate for a domestic water supply for no more than one single family dwelling.

RULING:

The protest to the granting of Application 27856 is hereby upheld and Application 27856 is herewith denied on the grounds that there is insufficient water available at the source to support the use as applied for.
