R U L I N G

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Applications 29052 and 29053 were filed on December 16, 1974 by Ward C. Mikkelson and C. M. Turley to appropriate underground water for irrigation purposes in the Imlay area of Pershing County. Each application is for 10 c.f.s. to irrigate 789 acres within the E $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 6, N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, S $\frac{1}{2}$, S $\frac{1}{2}$ N $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 7, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 8, T.32N., R.34E., M.D.M. The point of diversion under Application 29052 is within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ said Section 8 and the point of diversion under Application 29053 is within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ said Section 8.


These applications were protested on April 23, 1975 by the Pershing County Water Conservation District on the grounds "that the granting of said application will affect the water table and drainage and adversely affect the decreed waters of the Humboldt River".

A hearing in the matter of these applications as well as others filed in the Imlay Segment was held on September 3, 1975 in Lovelock, Nevada. A transcript of this hearing is available in the office of the State Engineer.

RULING:

The protests to the granting of Applications 29052 and 29053 are hereby overruled and permits will be issued upon receipt of the statutory permit fees and the duty of water shall be limited to 3.0 acre-feet per acre per year of land irrigated.
