R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 29270 was filed on March 17, 1975 in the name of Ellen Blair to appropriate 2.0 c.f.s. of water from Squaw Spring, the point of diversion to be located within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 17, T.7N., R.30E., M.D.B.&M., to be used for quasi-municipal service to 200 homes to be located within the E $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, W $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, E $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, W $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 17, T.7N., R.30E., M.D.B.&M. Application 29270 became ready for action on June 13, 1975 with no protests having been filed.

By letter of July 29, 1975 from the State Engineer's office, the applicant was informed that Application 29270 was ready to be approved and that in accordance with NRS 533.435 it would be necessary that the sum of \$20.00 for the issuance of a permit be submitted. A period of 30 days was allowed for the submission of the permit fee. No fee was received within this 30 day period, and therefore by certified letter dated August 29, 1975 the applicant was again notified that the permit fee was due and that if said fee was not received within 30 days from the date of that letter Application 29270 would be subject to denial. A properly endorsed receipt for this certified letter was received in the State Engineer's office on September 4, 1975. To date the required permit fee has not been submitted to the State Engineer's office.

RULING:

Application 29270 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant has failed to submit the required permit fee in accordance with NRS 533.435.
