GENERAL:

Application 30724 was filed on October 8, 1976 by Fred W. Newbold to appropriate 2.0 cubic feet per second of water from an underground source for irrigation and domestic purposes. The water is to be diverted from the source at a point in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16, T.21N.,R.70E., M.D.B.&M. The place of use is described as 200 acres located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16 and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, T.21N.,R.70E., M.D.B.&M. The period of use is January 1 to December 31 of each year.

A protest to the granting of this application was filed by William J. Henriob on January 27, 1977. The grounds of this protest are as follows: "This well is located about (one quarter) $\frac{1}{4}$ mile above the spring in which the water of the Pleasant Valley channel is supplied. From this spring and channel comes my irrigating water. If this well is pumped it may lower the water from this spring and thus lower my irrigating stream."

A field investigation into the matter of protested Application No. 30724 was held on May 10, 1977.

The results of data and information obtained from the field investigation indicate that the granting of this application would not tend to impair the value of existing rights.

RULING

The protest to the granting of Application 30724 is hereby overruled and a permit will be granted upon receipt of the statutory permit fees subject to existing rights.
