

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATION NO. 17387,
FILED ON SEPTEMBER 4, 1957, BY INDEX-
DALEY MINES CO. TO APPROPRIATE UNDER-
GROUND WATER FOR MINING, MILLING AND
DOMESTIC PURPOSES, WHICH WAS PROTESTED
ON MARCH 27, 1958 BY NEVADA MONARCH
CONSOLIDATED MINES CORPORATION. }

RULING

General:

From the field investigation made on June 26, 1958, it was found that the source to be appropriated under this application was water developed in a mine tunnel as a result of the mining operations of the applicant. Representatives of the protestant felt that their existing water rights would not be affected by the appropriation.

RULING

The protest to the granting of Application No. 17387 is herewith overruled on grounds that granting of the permit will not interfere with existing rights or be otherwise detrimental to the public welfare.

A permit will be issued under said application, upon receipt of the statutory permit fee.
