RULING 3058

GENERAL

Application 46915 was filed on May 17, 1983, by Natasha Mining Co. to appropriate 4.5 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for mining and milling purposes within all of Sections 23 and 24; NE1/4, NW1/4 and SE1/4 Section 25, T.13S., R.63E., M.D.B.&M. The point of diversion is described as being within the SE1/4 SE1/4 Section 23, T.13S., R.63E., M.D.B.&M.¹

Application 46916 was filed on May 17, 1983, by Natasha Mining Co. to appropriate 4.5 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for mining and milling purposes within all of Sections 23 and 24; NE1/4, NW1/4 and SE1/4 Section 25, T.13S., R.63E., M.D.B.&M. The point of diversion is described as being within the NE1/4 NW1/4 Section 25, T.13S., R.63E., M.D.B.&M.¹

Application 46917 was filed on May 17, 1983, by Natasha Mining Co. to appropriate 4.5 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for mining and milling purposes within all of Sections 23 and 24; NE1/4, NW1/4 and SE1/4 Section 25, T.13S., R.63E., M.D.B.&M. The point of diversion is described as being within the SE1/4 SE1/4 Section 23, T.13S., R.63E., M.D.B.&M.¹

FINDINGS OF FACT

I.

On April 9, 1984, a certified letter was sent to Natasha Mining Co., 417 Sugar Leo Road, St. George, Utah, 84770, requesting additional information concerning Applications 46915, 46916 and 46917. The certified letter and Certified Mail Receipt No. P369 809 739 were returned to this office stamped "Return to Sender", "No Such Number".¹

II.

A review of the records under Applications 46915, 46916 and 46917 revealed there has been no response to the described letter of inquiry within the time limit specified therein.

CONCLUSIONS

I.

The State Engineer has jurisdiction of the parties and the subject matter of this action.²

II.

The State Engineer may require additional information before approval or rejection of an application.³

III.

There has been no response to the request for additional information from the applicant under Applications 46915, 46916 and 46917.

RULING

Applications 46915, 46916 and 46917 are hereby denied on the grounds that additional information requested from the applicant was not received by the State Engineer and to approve said applications without the additional information requested would not be in the public interest.
