

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATIONS NOS.  
17986 AND 17987, FILED MAY 11, 1959  
BY THOMAS L. BLACKMON TO APPROPRIATE  
THE WATERS OF UNDERGROUND SOURCES FOR  
IRRIGATION AND DOMESTIC PURPOSES, IN  
NYE COUNTY, NEVADA.

RULING

General:

Applications Nos. 17986 and 17987 were filed  
in support of Desert Land Application Nev.-053058.  
On March 9, 1960 we were notified by the Bureau of  
Land Management, Reno, Nevada, that they had not taken  
action on the land application. As of the date of  
this ruling, the applicant does not have control of  
the land on which he plans to place the water to  
beneficial use.

RULING

Applications Nos. 17986 and 17987 are hereby  
denied on grounds that the applicant does not have  
control of the land on which he plans to place the  
water to beneficial use and that their granting  
would be detrimental to the public welfare.
