RULING

GENERAL

I.

Application 50633 was filed on February 25, 1987 by Saung Consolidated to appropriate 0.05 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for commercial/domestic purposes within the SW1/4 SW1/4 and SE1/4 SW1/4 Section 31, T.19N., R.29E. M.D.B.&M. Application 50633 became ready for action by the State Engineer's Office on July 2, 1987.

FINDINGS OF FACT

I.

The applicant was notified by letter from the State Engineer's Office dated September 16, 1987 that application 50633 was ready to be approved and that, in accordance with NRS 533.435, it would be necessary that the sum of \$100.00 be remitted to the Division of Water Resources. No fees were submitted as result of that notice.¹

II.

By certified letter dated April 1, 1988, the State Engineer's Office notified the applicant again that the \$100.00 permit fee must be remitted within 30 days of the date of the letter or application 50633 would be subject to denial. Properly endorsed receipts for the certified notice are on file in the office of the State Engineer. To date, no permit fees have been received for Application 50633.¹

CONCLUSIONS

I.

The State Engineer has jurisdiction in this matter under the provisions of NRS 533.325 and NRS 533.435.


II.

The applicant has been properly notified of the requirement for the submission of the permit fees and has failed to comply with that requirement.

Application 50633 is herewith DENIED on the grounds that the applicant has failed to submit the permit fees required under the provision of NRS 533.435.
