RULING

#3843

GENERAL

Application 56500 was filed on July 2, 1991, by Ronald M. and Susan J. Krump to change the point of diversion and place of use of 0.08 c.f.s., a portion of the waters of Thomas Creek previously appropriated under Truckee River Decree Claim No. 720. The proposed place of use is a portion of the NW1/4 SE1/4 Section 7, T.18N., R.20E., M.D.M. The proposed point of diversion is described as being within the NW1/4 SE1/4 Section 7, T.18N., R.20E., M.D.M. The use will remain as decreed.

FINDINGS OF FACT

Application 56500 was submitted to the State Engineer's office on July 2, 1991, accompanied by Check No. 3481 in the amount of \$100.00. After deposit the check was returned stamped "Not Sufficient Funds." Pursuant to NRS 533.435, a \$100.00 filing fee must accompany each application to change an existing water right.

CONCLUSIONS

I.

The State Engineer has jurisdiction of the parties and the subject matter of this action and determination under the provisions of NRS 533.325 and NRS 533.435.


II.

Since the check for the filing fee of Application 56500 was returned by the bank, Application 56500 was not accompanied by the statutory filing fee of \$100.00 as required under the provisions of NRS 533.435.

RULING

Application 56500 is herewith cancelled on the grounds that the applicant did not submit the application fee as required under the provisions of NRS 533.435.
