GENERAL

I.

Application 59106 was submitted on August 9, 1993, by Barbara Paradise to appropriate 0.1 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 24, T.19S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M. The point of diversion is described as being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 24, T.19S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M.¹

FINDINGS OF FACT

I.

Application 59106 was submitted to the State Engineer's office accompanied by a savings withdrawal form in the amount of \$250.00. After deposit, the form was returned stamped "not a transaction account". Pursuant to NRS 533.435, a \$250.00 filing fee must accompany each application to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada.

CONCLUSIONS

I.

The State Engineer has jurisdiction of the parties and the subject matter of this action and determination under the provisions of NRS 533.325 and NRS 533.435.²
