R U L I N G

General:

212 On December 22, 1960, protests to the granting of Appli-
cations Nos. 19104, 19105, 19106, and 19107, were filed by
Fred B. Houghton. Because of the failure of the protestant to
comply with requirements in filing his protests, the protest was
filed formally under Application No. 19104 and informally under
19105, 19106, and 19107.

Opinion:

It is the opinion of this Office that adequate legal notice
of the proposed change was given, and that the applicant complied
with all the required statutes in making the proposed change.

RULING

The protests to the granting of Applications No. 19104,
19105, 19106, and 19107, are herewith overruled on grounds that
their granting will not impair the value of existing rights or
be otherwise detrimental to the public welfare.

this ruling.
