R U L I N G

General:

8 Application No. 18109 was protested on November 18, 1959, by W. Dalton La Rue, Sr., and Juanita S. La Rue on grounds that protestants' stock watering rights would be adversely affected.

On November 25, 1959, in accordance with the statutes, a copy of the protest was mailed to M. K. Hudlow, but was returned unclaimed. On July 20, 1960, the protest was again mailed to the applicant and returned unclaimed. We have not been able to contact the applicant since the application was filed.

RULING

Application No. 18109 is herewith denied on grounds that this office has been unable to contact the applicant, and his failure to contact this office indicates that he has no further interest in the application.
