R U L I N G

General:

Protests to the granting of the applications were filed on March 31, 1958, by Herman L. Dreyer on grounds that the waters under the applications are in a service area used in common with other range users.

Informal protests were received from F. M. Fulstone, Inc., on April 3, 1958, stating that they are applicants for grazing privileges in the service area under the applications.

Upon investigation it was found that the service area of these waters is in an individual allotment of the applicant.

RULING

The protests to the granting of the applications are herewith overruled on grounds that their granting will not be detrimental to the public welfare. Permits will be issued under said applications on receipt of the statutory permit fees.
