R U L I N G

General:

Protests to the granting of this application were filed on:

- February 22, 1962, by Park Cattle Company
- March 26, 1962, by Alvin Delaney

A field investigation was made by this office on June 8, 1962.


The well was drilled to a depth of 193 feet and has 15 feet of 8-5/8 inch diameter casing cemented in the hole. Below 15 feet it is an open hole drilled in granite rock. The water then comes from fissures in the rock below 15 feet. The material in the first 15 feet of the hole is sand and rock and through which Edgewater Creek flows. If there is a leakage from the creek, the well would flow or pump a great deal more than the 45 g.p.m. that it test pumped.

Therefore, it is felt that the issuance of this application will not be detrimental to the Public Welfare Ruling.

RULING

The protests to the granting of Application 20228 are herewith overruled on grounds that its granting will not impair the existing rights or be detrimental to the public welfare. A permit will be issued under Application 20228 on receipt of the statutory permit fee.
