Application 12062 was filed October 25, 1947 by Constant Vener to appropriate 0.25 c.f.s. of underground water for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion is in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 36, T. 6 N., R. 50 E., M.D.B.&M.

Application 12063 was filed October 25, 1947 by Constant Vener to appropriate 0.25 c.f.s. of underground water for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion is in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 28, T. 6 N., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M.


The location of the proposed wells is in a range area used by Helen Williams, et al, and Fallini Brothers, that is appurtenant to the "Fallini Well" and the "Hot Creek Slough" and is generally grazed from these water sources.

It is the opinion of the State Engineer that the granting of permits under these applications would contravene the policy set up in the 1925 Stockwatering Act.

RULING

The protest of Helen Williams is sustained. Applications 12062 and 12063 of Constant Vener are therefore denied.
