R U L I N G

General:

Application 6494 was filed on June 22, 1921 by A. J. Mackie to appropriate 0.10 c.f.s. of the waters of Canyon Spring for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as being in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 23, T.5S., R.67 E., M.D.B.&M. and the place of use within the same subdivision. This application was protested on July 21, 1921 by Parlie Henrie on the grounds of interference with existing rights.

On August 27, 1965, the Bureau of Land Management, Las Vegas, Nevada, notified this office that, "We are opposed to granting a certificate to anyone but the Henrie Brothers or possibly Jack Lancaster. If neither of these parties have tried to obtain a certificate on this water, probably the application should be rejected." On June 4, 1965, the Bureau of Land Management notified this office that the location of the point of diversion and place of use are in the grazing allotment of the Henrie Brothers.

On April 9, 1965 a letter from this office was forwarded to Mr. A. J. Mackie requesting additional information under application 6494. This letter was returned on April 12, 1965 marked, "Address Unknown". It is the responsibility of the applicant to keep the State Engineer's office informed of any change in address. As of the date of this ruling, Mr. Mackie has expressed no interest or intentions in pursuing this application.

RULING


Application 6494 is denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to submit additional information as
