GENERAL

Application 2830 was filed on November 18, 1913, by Gerlach Live Stock Company for permission to appropriate 20.0 c.f.s. of water from Cottonwood Creek for irrigation (2,000 acres) and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion is described as being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 26, T.35N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use is described as being portions of Sections 1 and 2, T.35N., R.23E., Sections 10, 11, 12, 13, and 14, 23, 24, 25, 26, 35, 36, T.34N., R.23E., and Sections 1 and 2, T.33N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M. This application was transferred on December 15, 1943, to L. J. Holland.

A letter dated July 24, 1968, was forwarded by certified mail to Cantwell and Loomis, Attorneys at Law, the agents for the owner of record, requesting additional information necessary before a Permit could be issued under this application. A return receipt card signed by Cantwell and Loomis was received in this office.

RULING

Application 2830 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his agents failed to submit the requested information and approval of this application without said information would be detrimental to the public welfare.
