R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 4581 was filed by Fritz Elges on September 12, 1917 for permission to appropriate .25 c.f.s. of water from an Unnamed Spring for irrigation and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion is described as within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 25, T. 7 N., R. 36 E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use is described as 40 acres lying within undivided T. 7 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B.&M.

A protest was filed under this application by William F. Dressler on November 10, 1917.

A letter was sent to the applicant by certified mail on April 30, 1970 requesting additional information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application. This letter was returned stamped: "Deceased" by the Post Office Department. It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

Ruling

Application 4581 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant, or his successors in interest failed to submit the required information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application.
