RULING

Application 13801 was filed August 20, 1951 by Chas. Cecchini for Waste Waters of Alkali Spring for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion is located within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 26, T. 1 S., R. 41 E. This application was protested by the Goldfield Consolidated Mines Company on October 26, 1951, and by James M. Daniels on November 5, 1951.

RULING

Alkali Springs is located on the dividing line between the areas leased to Chas. Cecchini and James M. Daniels for grazing purposes by the Bureau of Land Management. The spring itself is on the privately owned land of the Goldfield Consolidated Mines Company.

The protests of both parties are neither upheld or overruled by this action; however, Application 13801 is denied since there is no provision in the Statutes of Nevada which provides for the appropriation of waste water.
