RULING

Application No. 15086 was filed by Irwin J. Larnin to appropriate 0.50 c.f.s. of water from an underground source at a point in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10, T. 20 S., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M. for the irrigation of 80 acres of land in the S $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10, T. 20 S., R. 60 E., M.D.M. and for domestic purposes.

The Bureau of Land Management has advised this office that Desert Land Application No. 012802 in the name of Irwin J. Larnin has been finally rejected and closed. Application No. 15086 was filed to appropriate water for the irrigation of the lands applied for under Desert Land Entry No. 012802.

The land to be irrigated under this application has been definitely closed to entry for agricultural purposes by the Government. In view of this action, Application No. 15086 is herewith denied on grounds that the applicant cannot gain entry to the land to be irrigated and therefore cannot place the water applied for to beneficial use.
