PRIATE WATER FROM AN UNDERGROUND SOURCE : RULING
IN CLARK COUNTY, NEVADA.)

Application No. 14046 was filed by Joseph C. Hergenhan to appropriate 3.0 c.f.s. of water from an underground source at a point in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 22, T. 22 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M. for the irrigation of 320 acres of land in the S $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 22, T. 22 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M. and for domestic purposes.

The Bureau of Land Management has advised this office that Desert Land Application No. 08031 in the name of Joseph C. Hergenhan has been finally rejected and closed. Application No. 14046 was filed to appropriate water for the irrigation of the lands applied for under Desert Land Entry No. 08031.

The land to be irrigated under this application has been definitely closed to entry for agricultural purposes by the Government. In view of this action Application No. 14046 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant cannot gain entry to the land to be irrigated and therefore cannot place the water applied for to beneficial use.
