R U L I N G

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GENERAL:

Application 28431 was filed on June 14, 1974 by Donald C. and Dorothy A. Anderson to appropriate 0.2 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for irrigation and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion is within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 4, T.16N.,R.22E., M.D.M. The place of use is described as 4 acres within the N $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 4, T.16N.,R.22E., M.D.M. The period of use to be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.


Permit 19733, Certificate 6917 and Permit 24780 in the name of the Dayton Valley Ranches Water Association are appurtenant to the proposed place of use described under Application 28431.

The Dayton Valley Groundwater Basin was designated on January 22, 1973, by order of the State Engineer. Present information available indicates that the estimated perennial yield of the Dayton Valley groundwater basin is 7,900 acre-feet. Existing water rights of record within the Dayton Valley groundwater basin exceed the estimate of perennial yield. Application 28431 is located within the area designated as the Dayton Valley Groundwater Basin.

RULING:

Application 28431 is hereby denied on the grounds that the granting of this application for additional withdrawal of water from this area of the Dayton Valley groundwater basin would adversely affect and tend to impair the value of existing water rights.
