R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 17999 was filed on May 14, 1959 by Henry G. and Dorothea McCleary to appropriate 8.0 cfs of water from an underground source for irrigation purposes. The proposed point of diversion is located within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 1, T.34N., R.39E., M.D.M. The place of use is described as 440 acres within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 1, T.34N., R.39E., M.D.M.; N $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  S $\frac{1}{2}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and N $\frac{1}{2}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 6; SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  and NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 5, all in T.34N., R.40E., M.D.M. Application 17999 has been assigned and now stands in the name of Piquet Ranches, Inc.

A protest to the granting of Application 17999 was filed on July 14, 1959, by the Pershing County Water Conservation District of Nevada on the grounds that the granting of said application will effect the water table and drainage and adversely effect the Decreed Waters of the Humboldt River and its Tributaries.

RULING:

The protest to the granting of Application 17999 is hereby overruled on the grounds that the granting will not impair the value of existing rights or be otherwise detrimental to the public welfare. A permit will be issued under Application 17999 upon receipt of the statutory permit fees.
