RULING

General:

Application No. 16572, filed June 22, 1955 by Caesar F. Squadrilli, and which was protested by The City of Las Vegas, designates the point of diversion as being in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 14, T. 21 S., R. 62 E., and the place of use as being 320 acres in the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 14, same township and range. Although Section 14 lies outside the boundary of the designated area, it is the opinion of the State Engineer's office that the water sought to be appropriated is the water of the Las Vegas Artesian Basin. Under the provisions of SEC. 10.5 added, Chap. 212, Stats. 1955, the State Engineer has determined that no water is available for irrigation purposes.

RULING

Application 16572 is denied for the reason that there is no water available for appropriation for irrigation purposes.
