It is the opinion of the State Engineer that there is underground water subject to appropriation and that the granting of a permit for the use of this water could not be detrimental to the existing rights of the Henry McCleary Timber Company.

The protests of the Henry McCleary Timber Company are therefore overruled and permits will be issued under Applications 13281 and 13282 upon receipt of the permit fees.
