APPROPRIATE THE WATERS OF SAN
ANTONIO PASS WELL FOR STOCKWATER-
ING PURPOSES IN NYE COUNTY, NEVADA

RULING

General:

A protest to the granting of the application was filed on May 5, 1950 by Jess Chance and Jess Chance, Jr. on grounds that the waters are within an area in which the protestant is entitled to graze. Upon investigation, it was found that the waters are within an area allotted to the applicant for grazing purposes.

RULING

The protest to the granting of Application No. 13263 is herewith overruled on grounds that the granting thereof will not interfere with any existing water right of the protestant. A permit will be issued under Application No. 13263 upon the receipt of the statutory permit fee.
