

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATIONS NOS.
17848 AND 17849, FILED ON FEBRUARY
19, 1959, BY WILLIAM B. WRIGHT, TO
APPROPRIATE GROUND WATER FOR IRRI-
GATION AND DOMESTIC AND FOR STOCK-
WATERING AND DOMESTIC PURPOSES,
RESPECTIVELY, IN ELKO COUNTY,
NEVADA.

RULING

General:

Application No. 17848 was filed to appropriate 1.0
c.f.s. for the irrigation of forty acres of land from
January 1st to December 31st of each year. Application No.
17849 was filed to appropriate 0.045 c.f.s. for watering
five hundred cattle from January 1st to December 31st of
each year. Protests to the granting of these applications
were filed on July 14, 1959, by the Pershing County Water
Conservation District on grounds that their granting would
adversely affect the decreed waters of the Humboldt.

RULING

The protests to the granting of Applications Nos.
17848 and 17849 are herewith overruled on grounds that their
granting will not impair the value of existing rights or be
otherwise detrimental to the public welfare.

Permits will be issued under these applications on
receipt of the statutory permit fees.
