
Application No. 11822 was filed by Howard Turley on April 10, 1947 to appropriate the waters of Crehore Basin Spring for stockwatering purposes. The proposed point of diversion is in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 1, T. 20 N., R. 33 E.

On June 16, 1947 said application was protested by the Kent Land & Live Stock Company.

Action on this application was delayed at the specific request of the Bureau of Land Management who were in the process of adjudicating the range. By letter dated February 23, 1950 from the Bureau of Land Management we were advised that said application should be denied for the reason that the location given is in the immediate neighborhood of appropriated water now owned by Kent Land & Livestock Company and the source of water applied for appears to be on the range allotted to the Company. Further, that the granting of said application would complicate the administration of the Grazing District insofar as Applicant Turley's allotment does not cover the area in which the spring applied for is located. We are further advised that from a personal examination by the Bureau of Land Management it appears that the location given in said application is erroneous and Mr. Turley's intention was to file on a water place slightly north of this area and which is north of the Kent allotment boundary and which would be within Mr. Turley's allotment. This was more or less substantiated by Mr. Turley when he visited this office on February 27th.

In view of the above, it appears that Application 11822 should be denied, for the reason that the granting of a permit under said application would impair the rights of Protestant Kent Land & Livestock Company, and for the further reason that the point of diversion of said spring is outside of the boundaries of Applicant Turley's range allotment.
