

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATION NO. 11821 IN NAME)
OF RUBERT R. SPENCER TO APPROPRIATE THE WATERS :
OF PINE GULCH SPRING FOR STOCKWATERING PURPOSES, : RULING
CHURCHILL COUNTY, NEVADA.)

Application No. 11821 was filed by Rubert R. Spencer April 10, 1947 to appropriate the waters of Pine Gulch Spring for stockwatering purposes. The proposed point of diversion is in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 31, T. 20 N., R. 36 E.


On June 19, 1947 said application was protested by Louis H. Danberg.

Action on this application was delayed at the request of the Bureau of Land Management pending adjudication of the range in this area.

By letter dated February 23, 1950 from the Bureau of Land Management, we were advised that the granting of a permit under this application would not interfere with the administration of the range in this area, provided that other livestock which might be granted the use of the range be allowed to use this water in common with Applicant Spencer.

It is therefore ordered that the protest of Louis H. Danberg be overruled and a permit granted to Rubert R. Spencer following receipt of the statutory permit fee, with the understanding that if any other livestock be granted the use of the range in common with Mr. Spencer that they be allowed the use of the water from said source.
