R U L I N G

General:

Application 20490 was filed on May 28, 1962 by Robert H. Hadley to appropriate 3.0 c.f.s. of water from an underground source in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 4, T. 33 N., R. 52 E., M.D.B.& M. The water is to be used for irrigation and domestic purposes on 300 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , N $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 4, N $\frac{1}{2}$  N $\frac{1}{2}$ , Section 9, T. 33 N., R. 52 E., M.D.B.& M.

The Carlin Town Government protested Application 20490 on the grounds that granting Application 20490 would diminish the waters of the spring serving the Town of Carlin.

A Field Investigation in the matter of the above application was held on November 4, 1965.

Opinion:


This office is of the opinion that the point of diversion under application 20490 is probably in a different sub-drainage area and is also too distant from Arthur Spring to measurably affect the spring flow. However, because of the possibility that there might be a direct underground connection, a time on-time off pumping record should be kept for comparison with spring flow records.

RULING

The protest of the Carlin Town Government is hereby overruled and application 20490 will be granted upon receipt of the statutory fees. The NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 9, T. 33 N., R. 52 E., M.D.B.& M., will be omitted as a place of use. The permit will be granted subject to existing rights and the permittee will be required to keep a time on-time off pumping record of irrigation diversion.
