R U L I N G

General:

Application No. 20774 was considered by the Las Vegas Valley Ground Water Board at their regular monthly meeting February 5, 1963. At this meeting it was pointed out that water was available from an existing North Las Vegas water distribution line on Nellis Boulevard.

The following is quoted from the meeting referred to above: "Mr. Crosby said he was withdrawing the application that was a few feet from Nellis Blvd." The application Mr. Crosby referred to is Application No. 20774. As of this date, Mr. Crosby has not withdrawn Application No. 20774.

At the February 5, 1963 meeting, no action was taken by the Las Vegas Valley Ground Water Board on Application No. 20774 other than to state that, "Application #20774 is to be withdrawn."

RULING

Application No. 20774 is herewith denied on the grounds that it would impair the value of existing water rights in the Las Vegas Artesian Basin, and would be detrimental to the public welfare to allow appropriations in an area served by an entity engaged in furnishing water.
