R U L I N G

General:

Application 17959 was filed on April 27, 1959 by Ross C. Osborn in support of Desert Land Entry Nevada 045321 for irrigation of 320 acres and for domestic purposes. The point of diversion is in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 9, T. 45 N., R. 38 E., M.D.B. & M.


The Bureau of Land Management rejected Desert Land Entry No. 045321 by a decision dated December 21, 1959, stating that there was insufficient water available for the irrigation of the land on a substantial basis and that U.S.G.S. groundwater report (Nevada Water Resources Bulletin No. 14) shows that the available water supply in the Quinn River Valley basin is already allocated to existing agricultural developments.

The result of this decision by the Bureau of Land Management is that the applicant does not own or control the land on which water under this application is proposed to be used.

RULING

Application 17959 is herewith denied on the grounds that the water proposed to be appropriated cannot be applied to beneficial use.
