RULING #5141

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Matthew Kim Sing Kile in the office of the State Engineer on August 13, 2001, together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 16735 was issued to Marantha Drilling & Pump Service for said filing fee.

The applicant was notified on April 17, 2002, by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on May 10, 2002, at 8:00 a.m. in Las Vegas, Nevada. This was the third time that the applicant was notified for examination.¹

The applicant appeared as scheduled and was examined by the Board. Based upon the applicant's responses to questions about the Regulation and drilling equipment and practices, the Board finds that the applicant failed to demonstrate a good knowledge of general drilling practices and experience as a well driller. The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Matthew Kim Sing Kile on May 10, 2002.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and pursuant to NAC § 534.282 Subsection 2, the application of Matthew Kim Sing Kile is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
