R U L I N G

GENERAL

An application for a well driller's license was received on December 20, 1971, with the statutory \$25.00 fee from G. P. Meadows. Receipt No. 3423 was issued on December 20, 1971 to the applicant.

Requests for references were forwarded to the persons listed on the application on December 20, 1971. References were received from three of the four persons listed on the application. A letter dated February 16, 1972 was forwarded by certified mail to Mr. Meadows requesting additional names for references and advising that his application would be reviewed by the Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board at the meeting scheduled for March 8, 1972. Mr. Meadows responded by letter dated February 20, 1972 with one additional person for reference and the fourth reference was received in this office on February 22, 1972.

The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board at the March 8, 1972 meeting recommended that this application be held until the next meeting and the applicant requested to appear. The applicant appeared as scheduled before the Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board on June 8, 1972. Mr. Meadows was questioned by members of the Advisory Board regarding his ability and experience as a well driller. The Advisory Board recommended denial of the application for a well driller's license by G. P. Meadows on the grounds that the applicant did not exhibit sufficient knowledge of well drilling.

RULING

The application for a well driller's license filed by G. P. Meadows is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant has not demonstrated sufficient training and experience to qualify as a well driller.
