R U L I N G

General

An application for a well driller's license was received on July 24, 1972, with the statutory \$25.00 filing fee from Jesse Hold. Receipt No. 3615 was issued on July 24, 1972, to the applicant. Requests for references were forwarded to persons listed on the application on July 24, 1972.

By certified mail dated August 18, 1972, the applicant was advised that four references had been received but none related to the applicant's ability as a well driller. The applicant was requested to submit four additional names of persons having knowledge of his ability as a well driller. Also, by this letter the applicant was requested to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board at the meeting scheduled for September 8, 1972, for an oral interview.

The applicant appeared as scheduled and was questioned by members of the Advisory Board regarding his knowledge and experience as a well driller. The Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Jesse Hold for a well driller's license on the grounds of insufficient experience as a well driller.

Ruling

The application for a well driller's license filed by Jesse Hold is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant does not have sufficient experience to qualify as a well driller.
