R U L I N G

General:

An Application for a Nevada well driller's license was received in this office on May 13, 1974, with the statutory \$25.00 fee from Marvin Jackson, 109 Zia Street, Las Vegas, Nevada 89128. Receipt No. 3882 for the \$25.00 fee was issued on May 13, 1974, to Patrick H. Thompson, Thompson Drilling Co., Inc., 3215 Cinder Lane, Las Vegas, Nevada 89103.

Requests for references were forwarded to five (5) persons or firms as listed in the application on May 13, 1974. Four (4) responses were received to the requests for reference, two were unsatisfactory references.

The applicant was advised by certified mail dated May 24, 1974, that a time was set on the agenda for him to appear for an oral interview before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board at the regular meeting scheduled for June 7, 1974. By this letter, notice was given that the Advisory Board requires at least four (4) satisfactory references from persons having knowledge of the applicant's ability and experience as a well driller.

The applicant failed to appear as scheduled before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board for an oral interview.


By letter dated June 19, 1974, by certified mail, Mr. Jackson was advised that the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board reviewed his application at the regular meeting scheduled on June 7, 1974, and requested additional names and addresses of persons having knowledge of his experience and ability as a well driller for reference. No response was received from Mr. Jackson to this request for information.


Ruling:

The application for a Nevada well driller's license filed by Marvin Jackson is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to submit the required number of satisfactory references and failed to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board for an oral interview,

and, therefore, it cannot be determined that the applicant has sufficient knowledge and experience to qualify as a well driller.
