RULING

FINDING OF FACTS

An application for a Nevada well driller's license was filed by Lynn Carrol Hunt in the Office of the State Engineer on December 12, 1986, together with the statutory filing fee of \$50.00. Receipt No. 8764 was issued to N.A. Degerstron, Inc. for said filing fee.

Requests for five references were mailed on December 15, 1986. A response was received from four of the individuals. The applicant was notified by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on January 15, 1987. The applicant did appear and the Board recommended that he return at the next meeting, in April.


CONCLUSIONS

The applicant was notified by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board for an oral interview on April 2, 1987. The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board recommends denial of the application of Lynn Carrol Hunt.

RULING

The application of Lynn Carrol Hunt is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant has failed to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
